APPLICATION INFORMATION

Where does the money come from?

Each year The Center gives local students and educators in Blaine County scholarships to further their education in the arts and humanities through four different scholarships. This scholarship program is made possible through funds raised at The Center's Annual Wine Auction and private donations.

EDUCATOR SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for Blaine County educators currently teaching in either the public or private sector. Educators must teach pre-K through high school.

This scholarship supports formal professional development linking to the visual arts, performing arts and/or humanities.

The amount of this award is limited to \$1200. Please note this scholarship does not cover equipment purchases.

HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP *grades 9–12*

Applicants must be currently enrolled in grades 9th–12th in Blaine County. This includes home schooled, private and public school students.

Applicants must be looking to further their studies in the arts and humanities outside of regular school hours. These scholarships are to be used for formal study with a school or individual instructor.

Preference will be given to students who choose to study the visual arts (ceramics, drawing, painting, graphic design, photography, film, architecture, etc.) and performing arts (theatre, music, dance, voice). The humanities will also be taken into consideration (art history, creative writing, literature, language studies).

Multiple awards are given annually. Recipients can receive up to \$3000. These scholarships do not cover equipment purchases. Funds awarded must be used during the time frame of April 2017–February 2018.

EZRA POUND SCHOLARSHIP *grade 11*

Applicants must be currently enrolled in the 11th grade in Blaine County. This includes home schooled, private and public school students.

Applicants must study in the visual arts. Applicants

should be able to demonstrate that they have exhausted all opportunities for visual arts study within the valley and have a strong portfolio of work samples.

One award of \$5000 is given annually. This scholarship does not cover equipment purchases. Funds awarded must be used during the summer of 2017.

GAY V. WEAKE SCHOLARSHIP *grade 12 or college*

Applicants must be currently enrolled in 12th grade in Blaine County (includes home schooled, private and public school students) or applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student in college majoring in the arts or humanities.

Preference will be given to those majoring in visual arts and/or performing arts; some humanities will be taken into consideration (art history, creative writing).

This is a renewable scholarship of \$2000 per year in undergrad college. This scholarship only covers tuition at an accredited college or university. Funds awarded must be used during the time frame of April 2017–February 2018.

Applications are evaluated in the following areas:

- Selected program of study
- Interest, experience and enthusiasm
- Work samples
- Two letters of recommendation
- Transcript
- Financial need
