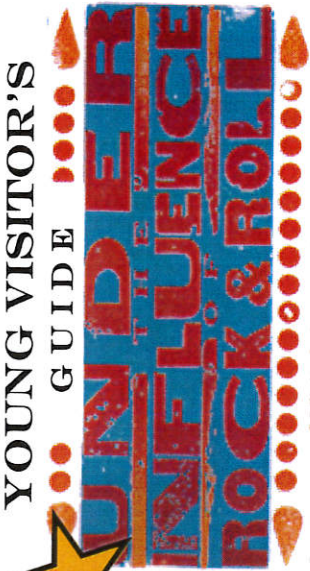


Think of a song you like and let your pencil dance to the beat on this paper.
